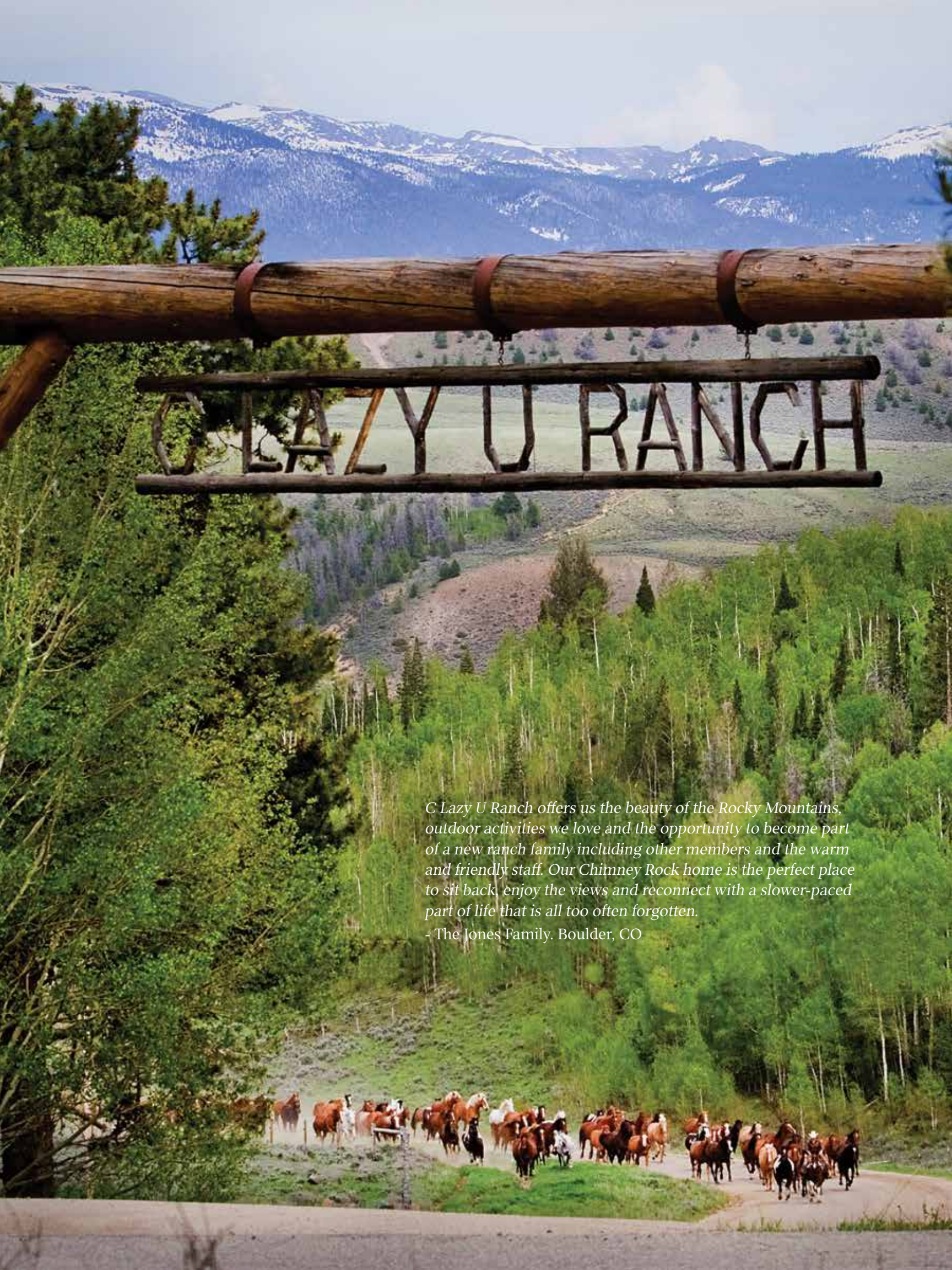

PROTECTING A CHERISHED LANDSCAPE AND ITS WESTERN TRADITIONS

As the ranch looks toward preserving a balanced lifestyle that has attracted people to this magical valley for so long, it has strategically prevented development of home sites in wildlife and view shed areas. To preserve the feeling of wide-open spaces, the master plan consists of a maximum of 40 ranch sites on no more than 35 acres each. A designated one-to-three-acre building envelope makes each ranch site close enough for neighbors to walk over for dinner gatherings, while keeping these homes from intruding on one another's privacy and views.

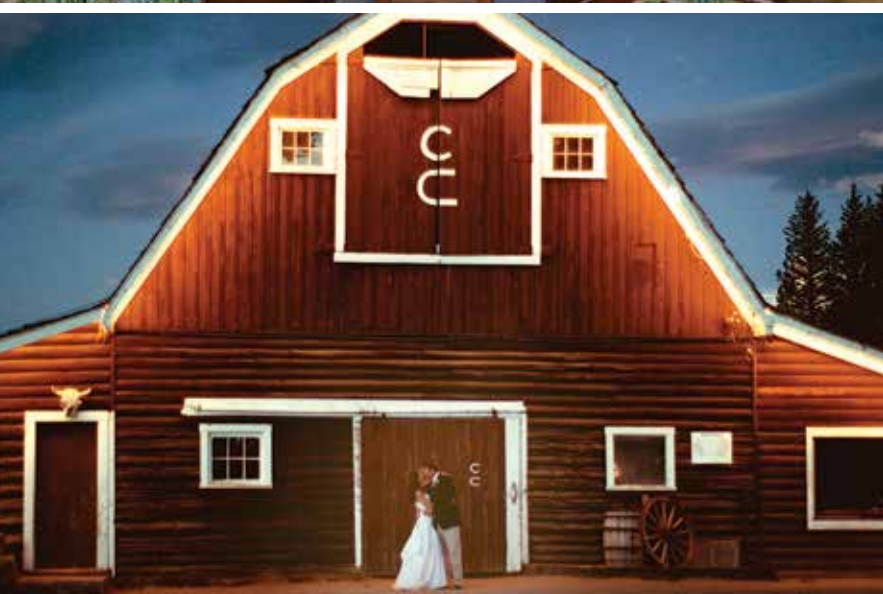
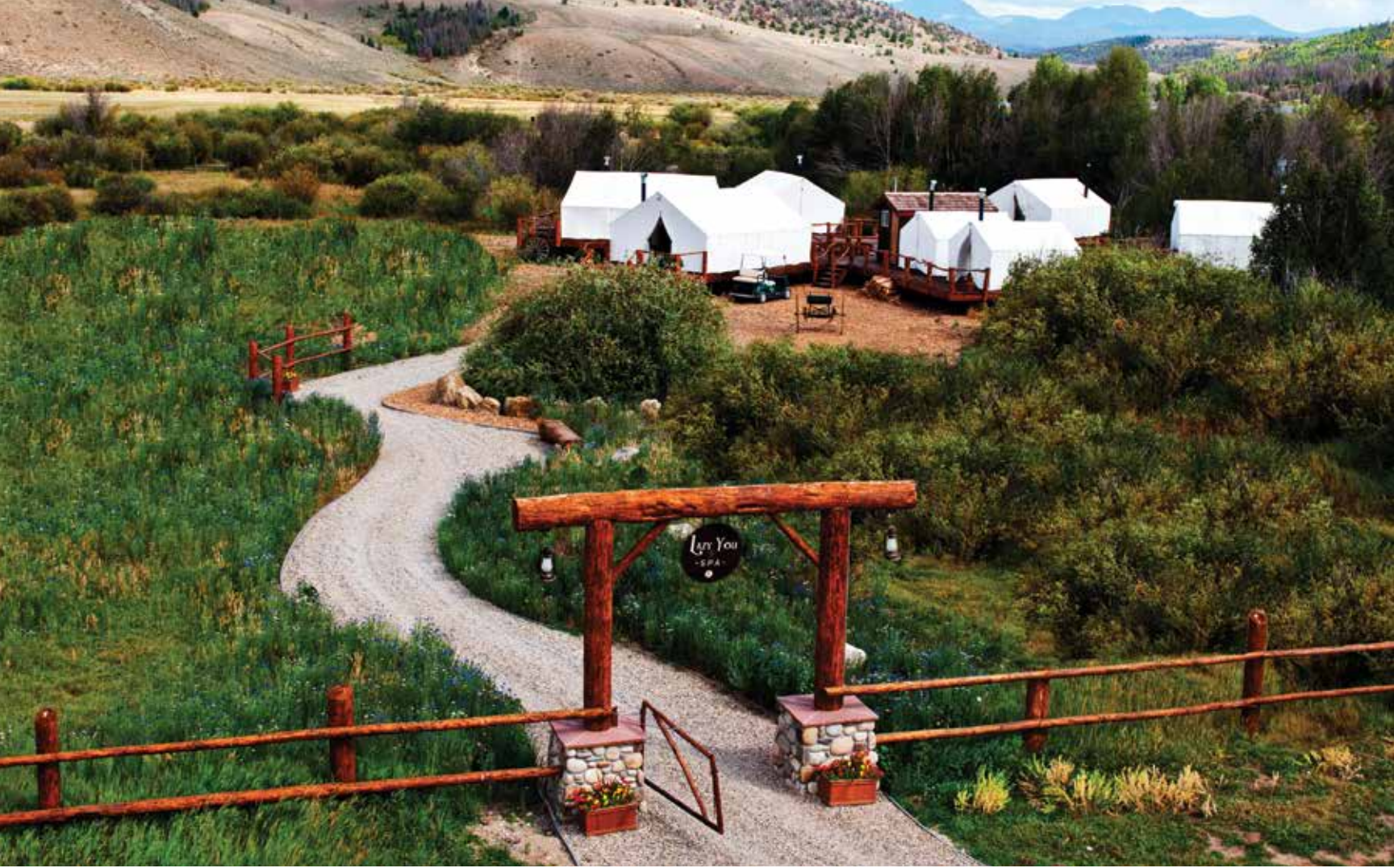
THE PATIO HOUSE:

Within view of the Orvis-endorsed fly fishing lodge, cast your luck along the shores of a trout-filled pond. Here, professional instructors offer fly fishing clinics to get you in the rhythm of the cast. Just a short stroll away, you can fly fish for wild trout with your guide along the two miles of private water on Willow Creek and lake fish on Willow Creek Reservoir. You might even try your hand fly fishing on our private two mile stretch of the nearby Colorado River.

Winter Activities

Escape into a winter wonderland and explore the majestic beauty of C Lazy U. The hours of daylight are fewer in winter than in summer but every bit as packed with activities. Try these:

- Downhill ski via the ranch's own passenger snowcat on C Lazy U's private groomed and un-groomed mountain.

- Snowmobile into thousands of acres of untracked wilderness.

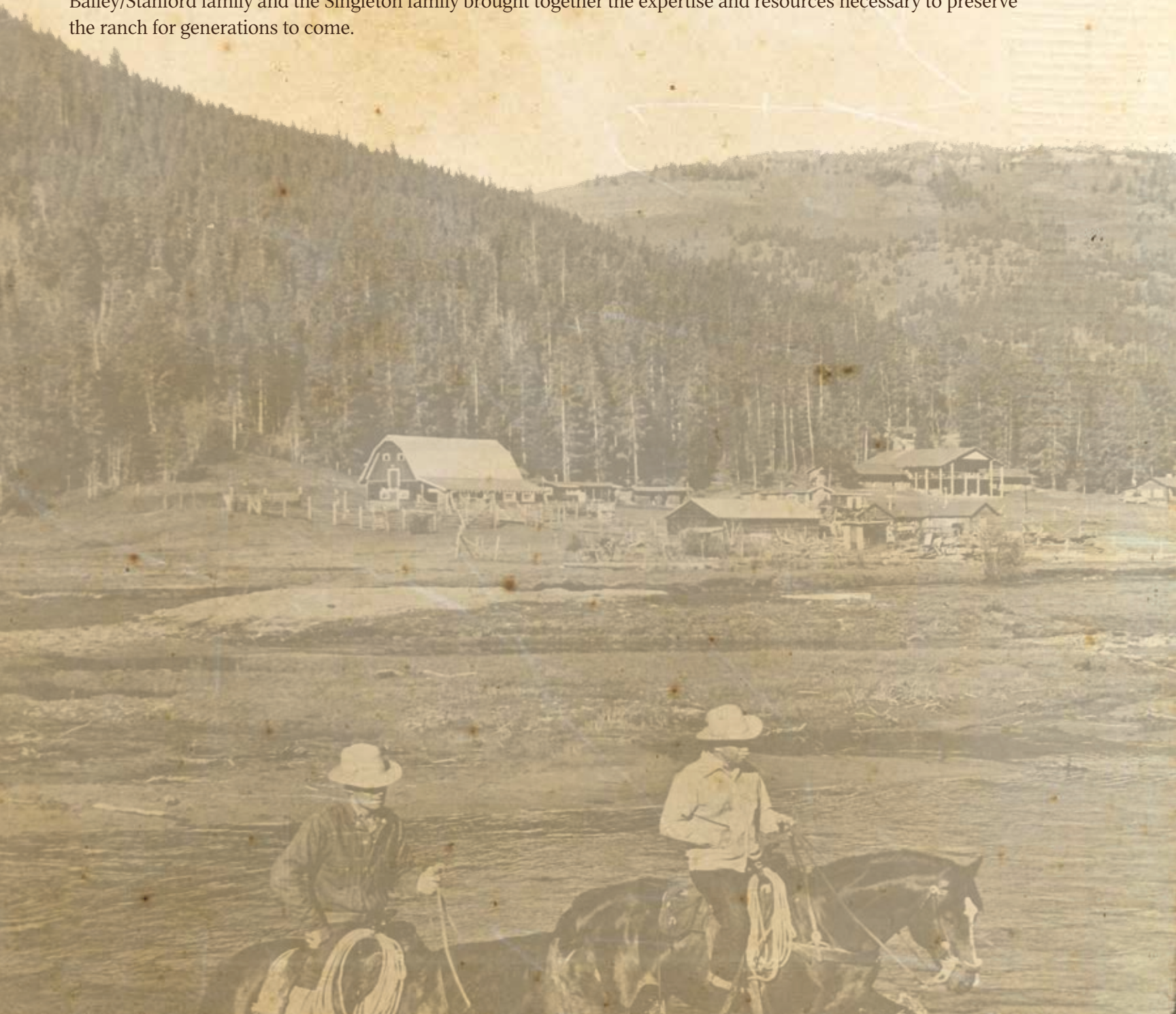
Families Unite as Stewards of this Pristine Land

C Lazy U boasts a past as twisting as the river that carved the shapes suggesting the ranch's name into this landscape. Back in the late 1800s, the Curtis family saw the promise of this land and staked its claim to a homestead. Jack and Gertrude Smilie then bought the ranch in the early 1900s. They started a guest ranch in 1919 where visitors enjoyed horseback riding, trout fishing, and bear hunting. The original barn was built in 1925.

After purchasing C Lazy U in 1945, Dick and Katie Schoenberger from New York City blended the quintessential western ranch experience. They established a casual mountain elegance that set a standard for attracting guests from around the globe. As part of their plan, the Schoenbergers oversaw construction for the Lodge in 1947. Its logs were felled on the Baldy hillside above and hauled down the hill to the site. There, they were hand-peeled, notched, and set in place using pioneering ingenuity.

Having fallen in love with C Lazy U while spending their honeymoon in one of the guest cabins, George and Virginia Mullin bought the ranch in 1973. Then, after visiting the ranch for three decades, Clark and Peg Murray fell so deeply under its spell, they bought it from the Mullins in 1988. The Murray family ran it until 2008.

Within the span of just under 100 years, only four families have owned this pristine property. Then in 2008, out of their mutual love and appreciation for C Lazy U, two families united to preserve its legacy. The new family partnership of the Bailey/Stanford family and the Singleton family brought together the expertise and resources necessary to preserve the ranch for generations to come.





Meet the Families Committed to Tradition and Preservation

Two families have embraced the value of an extraordinary lifestyle with endless imagination and a deep commitment to the land itself.

The Bailey/Stanford family fell in love with the C Lazy U during a Buck Brannaman horsemanship clinic in 1999. They have since built a home at the C Lazy U Homesteads and regularly stay at the ranch to enjoy frequent family retreats away from their home in Denver.

The Singleton family was so enchanted with C Lazy U's legacy as guests, they contributed to preserving its lifestyle by acquiring a significant portion of the deeded property prior to becoming owners of the ranch itself. Recently, they constructed their own home onsite as a retreat away from home.

Both the Bailey/Stanford and Singleton families embrace the long-term preservation goals of the ranch and consider themselves stewards of this magnificent property. Both families share in the love of being intricately involved in the operations ensuring that members and guests alike experience the magic that attracted them both to the ranch many years ago.
